WCCHS Sport Society – Letter of Support - Basketball Court & Track Lines

DESCRIPTION/BACKGROUND:

The Willow Creek High School Sport Society is looking for letter of a support as they apply for the Community Foundations of Lethbridge and Southern Alberta, Community Priorities Grant for the following projects on Livingstone School Division property.

1. Basketball Court, fence repair, resurfacing the concrete floor and painting the lines
2. Track, painting the lines to spec

The Town of Claresholm, Claresholm Football, and Livingstone Range School division collaborated in 2018 to repair drainage on the football field and replaced the dirt/shale track with a paved track. Since then, the Town has had 3 estimates for the lines to be painted on the track. This project is long overdue and will benefit not only the youth participating in track and field, or physical education, but will impact adults in our area who have goals of their own to reach.

The Basketball court is a popular area during the warmer months. Claresholm Ball Hockey has been encouraged to use the Basketball courts instead of the newly resurfaced Tennis and Pickleball courts. This facility has been in disrepair for some time. With these updates there will be increased opportunities for outdoor recreation for community members, and those within our region.
