Our society provides prevention, case management, mediation, education, and awareness to support seniors in rural Southern Alberta.

We are writing to formally invite the Town of Claresholm to appoint a Council representative to sit on our Board of Directors. This appointment would help strengthen collaboration between municipal, health, and community partners, ensuring a coordinated and effective response to the needs of older adults in our region.

Board meetings are held once per month from September through June, on the second Wednesday of each month from 9:00 a.m. to 10:30 a.m. All meetings are held virtually to accommodate participation from across the region.

The time commitment is approximately 1.5 hours per month, and your representation would provide valuable insight into local priorities and strengthen our ability to serve residents within the MD of Willow Creek.
