Community Priorities

Priority #1: Enhance Road Safety – Speeding/Distracted Driving**Updates and Comments:**

During this Quarter, 48 reports of Speeding Offences were received, either by complaints from the public or police generated, resulting in 32 charges being laid. As well, 11 reports of Distracted Driving were received resulting in 9 charges being laid.

Overall, there have been 167 Traffic-Related Offence complaint made resulting in 67 charges to date. Objective expected to exceed initial targeted values.

Priority #2: Crime Reduction – Property Crime**Updates and Comments:**

Members continue to regular patrols throughout the Detachment area, including the Towns of Claresholm and Stavely as well as the surrounding MD of Willow Creek. Persons on various Police Enforceable Conditions continue to be checked and monitored.

During this Quarter, there were approx. 25 persons, either on Warrant Status or on Court or Police imposed conditions, ranging from Curfews, No Contact with certain persons and No Go certain places. 6 Compliance Checks were conducted on conditions. All were deemed compliant.

One Suppression Shift occurred this Quarter by SAD CRU resulting in 1 subject being located on an outstanding Warrant.

Objective on track = 50 checks.





Priority #3: Communicating Effectively – Community Relations.

Updates and Comments:

During this Quarter, 10 various Media Releases/Public Advisories were completed and sent to the local media. These primarily focused on current/recent Crime Trends as well as Safety Tips for various summer activities. Also, regular monthly Police Reports continue to be submitted to keep the community informed on Policing Activities in the area.

The NCO I/c has also attended 3 council meetings this period as well as a Rural Crime Watch Meeting with the MD of Willow Creek.

Regular Police patrols continue to be conducted within the communities of Claresholm and Stavely as well as the surrounding MD of Willow Creek. Foot patrols have also been occurring, but primarily in the community of Claresholm and the local tavern therein.

Comments:

Police Officers: Of the seven established positions, five officers are currently working. There are two officers on Medical leave. There is no hard vacancy at this time.

Detachment Support: Of the two established positions, three resources are currently working with none on special leave. There is one position with two resources assigned to that position. There is no hard vacancy at this time.

Final Comments: All initiatives are currently on-track with most expected to exceed targeted goals. During this Quarter, the Claresholm Detachment has had 1 member return to duty, albeit, near the end of this Reporting Period. 2 members remain on long-term ODS (off duty sick). Efforts continue to be made to achieve the goals set forth in this Plan. Overtime members have been utilized in the past to assist with shift coverages and to help achieve the APP Objectives.
