Rowan House Society offers various supports and services within our seven core programs:

- 24 Hour Support Line
- Emergency Shelter
- Children's Program
- Preventative Education
- Outreach Program
- Legal Resource Navigator Program
- Safe at Home Program

24 Hour Support Line



The 24-hour Support Line provides telephone and texting responses to all individuals seeking crisis support through safety planning, information or navigation to the program or supports that best suit their needs. The 24-hour Support Line is available in multiple languages through CanTalk.

For the April 1, 2024 – March 31, 2025, fiscal year, we responded to **2, 108** calls and texts.

Emergency Shelter



The Emergency Shelter is a short-term (30-day) stay intended to provide a safe, supportive environment for women, with or without children, who have left violent and abusive situations and need a safe place or emergency housing.

For the April 1, 2024 – March 31, 2025, fiscal year, we supported **211 women and children.**

Children's Program



The Children's Program offers specialized programming for children that focuses on building self-esteem and developing coping skills for managing anxiety. Caregivers are encouraged to be a part of their child's learning by utilizing the structure in the Child Care Center where staff can assist in modelling healthy relationships, positive interactions, and child-centered play to facilitate a healthy parent-child attachment.

The Children's Program provides Parenting Groups to discuss parenting and the impacts of domestic violence and abuse.

For the April 1, 2024 – March 31, 2025 fiscal year, we supported **209 children.**

Preventative Education



The Preventative Education Program strives to break the cycle of abuse by providing Healthy Connections groups, education, and awareness for youth in schools, as well as presentations for the public.

For the April 1, 2024 – March 31, 2025 fiscal year, we **provided 153 presentations to 3,789 students.**

Outreach Program



The Outreach Program is designed to address and meet the needs of all individuals (regardless of race, cultural or spiritual background, gender identity or sexual orientation) affected by violence and abuse through one-to-one contact and support in a community setting.

For the April 1, 2024- March 31, 2025 fiscal year we supported **132 individuals and indirectly impacted 178 children.**

Legal Resource Navigator Program



The Legal Resource Navigator Program offers information and support to assist individuals in developing a better understanding of family law matters and protection orders, while ensuring individuals are provided with wraparound support.

For the April 1, 2024- March 31, 2025 fiscal year we supported **85 individuals and assisted 54 court orders**.

Safe at Home Program



The Safe at Home Program is designed to be an alternative approach to addressing domestic violence and abuse. The Safe at Home Outreach Workers work with the person causing harm by providing the following: "Cool Down Hotel", one to one support, and groups.

For the April 1, 2024- March 31, 2025 fiscal year we supported **27 individuals served and 118 individual sessions. Additionally, 54 group sessions**.

Claresholm



Our partnership with Claresholm Centre for Mental Health & Addictions provides clients access to Healthy Connections and other programs during and after treatment, strengthening prevention of domestic violence and abuse.

We offer all 7 of our core programs to Claresholm residents, and our community-based programs are actively involved in the Claresholm community.
