PURSUANT to sections 199, 216.4, 606 and 692 of the Municipal Government Act, Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000, Chapter M-26, as amended, the Council of the Town of Claresholm in the Province of Alberta has given first reading to Bylaw No.1825, which on final passage would amend the Town of Claresholm Municipal Development Plan No.1644.

THE PURPOSE of proposed Bylaw No. 1825 is to reflect lands annexed within the Town of Claresholm by order in council 213/2023 and to make textural corrections to maintain accurate policy references and improve document clarity.

THEREFORE, TAKE NOTICE THAT a public hearing to consider proposed Bylaw No. 1825 will be held in the Town of Claresholm Council Chambers at 7:00 p.m. on Monday, March 9, 2026.

AND FURTHER TAKE NOTICE THAT anyone wishing to make a presentation regarding the proposed bylaw should contact the Town Development Services Manager no later than 2:00 p.m. on March 5, 2026 (procedure will be provided to any persons or group of persons acting on behalf of anyone who is affected). Both written and/or verbal presentations may be given at the public hearing, or pre-register to speak if using the electronic participating system.
