



Infrastructure Services Report

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Director of Infrastructure

Arena

The rink dividers have arrived and are being utilized for the summer programming at the Arena.



Parks

Amundsen Park is virtually completed. The park was seeded, and irrigation has been running to try to get the grass established. The angle parking on the South side, as well as North of Creative Industries has been completed just in time for Fair Days. Lines still need to be painted, that will be completed when our shipment comes in.

The Skatepark is complete and landscaping was finished with topsoil being brought in and the whole area seeded. There remains work to be done on the East side of the park, but the site is still too wet to get our equipment in. We will finish as the site conditions allow.

Town Buildings

Regular maintenance is occurring on all town buildings. The radio tower was removed from the firehall and site grading will be completed.

Garbage

Garbage collection is going well, no issues to report.

Sanitary Sewers

Regular monthly maintenance continues in the sanitary system. No issues to report with the sanitary sewers. Any issues that come up are dealt with promptly.

Cemetery

Maintenance continues at the cemetery. Our summer help is working diligently to keep the grass mowed.

Streets

Line painting was completed in the end of July. The crews worked until they ran out of paint. More has been ordered to finish some places that were missed.



Equipment

The sanding truck went to Edmonton for warranty work. A new hydraulic pump and manifold was installed that is better suited to the sanding system we use.

Sidewalks

The sidewalk replacement program is completed, with about 450m of sidewalk replaced, along with wheelchair ramps and some curb and gutter.

Multiple downtown corners and wheelchair ramps will be replaced in the coming weeks, with one already being finished.

Water Distribution

No concerns with water. Town crews are working on the hydrant maintenance and flushing program as time allows.



Storm Water/Drainage

Westlynn Storm Phase 2 is under construction. Utility crossings are proving to be difficult again, with problems being encountered with a TELUS fiber line. A solution has been found, we are just waiting on TELUS to do their part. The rest of the pipe has been installed, along with the headwall. Site grading and landscaping will be done once the project is complete.

Recycling

No complaints with recycling. The ground work is being done for the EPR recycling program, which if successful, will take the burden of cost of recycling away from the consumers and put it on the producers.

Staff

The Operator 1 and Laborer positions have both been filled. Staff training is happening daily on the job.
